3.- They arrived very late because they had a flat tyre

If **THEY HADN'T HAD A FLAT TYRE, THEY WOULDN'T HAVE ARRIVED LATE**

4.- If he doesn't apologize we will never invite him here again.

Unless **HE APOLOGIZES WE WILL NEVER INVITE HIM HERE AGAIN**

5.-Many people still remember the assassination of President Kennedy.

President Kennedy **'S ASSASSINATION IS STILL REMEMBERED (BY MANY PEOPLE)**

6.- If you want my advice, get a good lawyer.

You **SHOULD GET A GOOD LAWYER**

7.- A university degree isn't necessary for that job.

You **DON'T NEED (TO HAVE) A UNIVERSITY DEGREE FOR THAT JOB .**

8.-Perhaps my father will pick you up.

My father. **MAY PICK YOU UP**

9.- My car needs cleaning. I'll take it tomorrow.

(must) **MY CAR MUST BE CLEANED BY TOMORROW**

10.- Do you want to go to Saint Moritz this winter ?

(like) **WOULD YOU LIKE TO GO TO SAINT MORITZ THIS WINTER?**

11.- We expect her to pass her driving test. She drives well.

She **IS EXPECTED TO PASS HER DRIVING TEST, AS SHE DRIVES WELL**

12.- The government should pass a law against pollution.

A law **AGAINST POLLUTION SHOULD BE PASSED BY THE GOVERNMENT**

13.- She didn't tell anyone about the phone call.

No one **WAS TOLD ABOUT THE PHONE CALL**

14.- Never underestimate the importance of a good education.

The importance **OF A GOOD EDUCATION SHOULD NEVER BE UNDERESTIMATED**

15.- That house is still up for sale.

Nobody **HAS BOUGHT THAT HOUSE YET**

16.- Would it be possible for me to take the car?.

Would it be alright if **I TOOK THE CAR.?**



17.- Can I read one of your books?.

Is it **OK IF I READ ONE OF YOUR BOOKS?**

18.- The teacher said the report must be finished by next week.

The teacher insisted on **FINISHING THE REPORT / HAVING THE REPORT FINISHED BY NEXT WEEK**

19.- Be careful not to drop the vase. Whatever **HAPPENS, DON'T DROP THE VASE**

20.- There were 100 redundancies in that company last summer.

100 workers. **WERE MADE REDUNDANT IN THAT COMPANY LAST SUMMER**

21.-I would prefer if we attended a late show.

I'd rather **ATTEND A LATE SHOW/ I'D RATHER WE ATTENDED A LATE SHOW**

22.-I won't let you forget about your appointment.

I'll **REMIND YOU OF YOUR APPOINTMENT**

23.- They crossed the Atlantic in three days.

It **TOOK THEM 3 DAYS TO CROSS THE ATLANTIC**

24.- She isn't old enough to play in the championship.

She is too **YOUNG TO PLAY IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP**

25.- Someone almost certainly stole the car during the night.

The car must **HAVE BEEN STOLEN DURING THE NIGHT**

26.- He didn't become an accountant because he failed his exams.

IF HE HADN'T FAILED HIS EXAMS, HE WOULD HAVE BECOME AN ACCOUNTANT

27.- He gave up cigarettes when he was thirty.

He stopped **SMOKING AT THE AGE OF 30**

28.- Few people speak Gaelic in Ireland.

There aren't **MANY PEOPLE WHO SPEAK GAELIC IN IRELAND**

29.- My elder sister doesn't speak Spanish, nor does my other sister.

Neither of **MY SISTERS SPEAKS SPANISH.**

30.- Running a big car like that can't be all that cheap.

It must **BE EXPENSIVE TO RUN A BIG A CAR LIKE THAT**

31.- Jennifer started teaching six years ago.

Jennifer has **BEEN TEACHING FOR 6 YEARS**

32.- What do you find most interesting about the film?

What interests. **YOU THE MOST ABOUT THE FILM ?**

33.-I was amazed by the things he said. I thought what **HE SAID WAS AMAZING**
