Present Simple Affirmative	Anna prays a lot
Present Simple Negative	Anna doesn't pray a lot
Present Simple Interrogative	Does Anna pray a lot?
Present Continuous Affirmative	Anna is praying a lot
Present Continuous Negative	Anna is praying a lot
Present Continuous Interrogative	Is Anna praying a lot?

ROBERT / TO STUDY/ HARD	
Present Simple Affirmative	Robert studies hard
Present Simple Negative	Robert doesn't study hard
Present Simple Interrogative	Does Robert study hard?
Present Continuous Affirmative	Roberto is studying hard
Present Continuous Negative	Roberto isn't studying hard
Present Continuous Interrogative	Is Robert studying hard?
