SCRIPT.

THERESA: You're not going to believe what Oh, God. Garret.

GARRET: Trust you?

THERESA: They've all been found and people saw it in the column and they wrote. I swear to God, I was going to tell you, Garret. Garret, wait.

GARRET: Why did you do this? Why?! Were you curious? It's goddamn research!

THERESA: No, I'm falling in love with you! First in the letters and then when I met you! And I'm sorry! I was afraid! I was afraid if I told you that I would push you away! Just like I'm doing now. Wait! No matter what you think of me, and no matter what happens now, I want you to know how much I care for you. And it shouldn't matter. what brought us together, Garret.

GARRET: I sent those letters into the sea to her. Not to you! Not to all your friends at work!

THERESA: I know.

GARRET: They all knew about me, didn't they? All about Catherine?

THERESA: My life was changed by those three letters. I didn't want it printed in the paper.

GARRET: Two letters.

THERESA: You've got to believe me.

GARRET: I sent two letters to Catherine.

THERESA: What? I have all of the letters. I have all three.

GARRET: Where's the third letter? Is it in that drawer? Catherine?

“ To all the ships at sea and all the ports of call. To my family and to all friends and strangers. This is a message and a prayer. The message is that my travels taught me a great truth.
