



ORACIONES CONDICIONALES MIXTAS.

▪ Observa los siguientes ejemplos:

- “If we **had saved** some money you **we would have gone** on holidays”
- “If we **had saved** some money you **we would go** on holidays now”

En el primer caso, la oración condicional es de tercer tipo y se refiere a acciones pasadas (no ahorramos dinero y como consecuencia no pudimos ir de vacaciones)

Sin embargo, en el segundo, vemos que se producen dos cambios con respecto al primer ejemplo: en forma y en significado:

1.- Forma: “If we **had saved** some money, **we would go** on holidays now”

Past Perfect
Conditional Simple

2.- Significado: La oración condicional se refiere al presente (como no ahorramos en su momento en el pasado, **ahora** no podemos irnos de vacaciones)
