- 1.- I **HAVE LOST** (lose) my key. Have you seen it by any chance?

- 4.- - Jim is learning German.  
- Really?. How long **HAS HE LEARNT/LEARNED** (learn) it?
- 5.- She **HAS WRITTEN** (write) three times already, but she hasn't got an answer yet.
