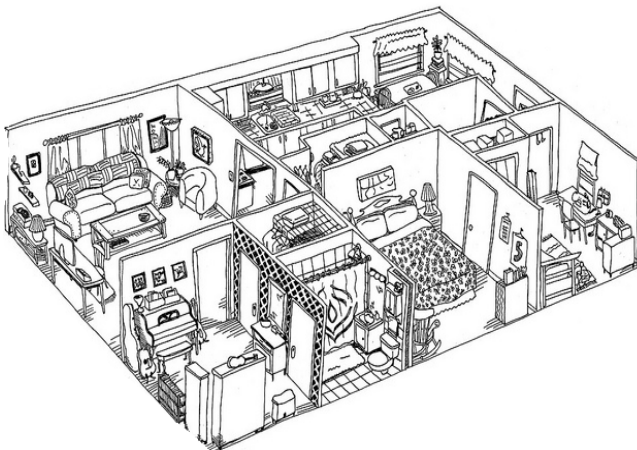

2.- THE ADJECTIVES (LOS ADJETIVOS)

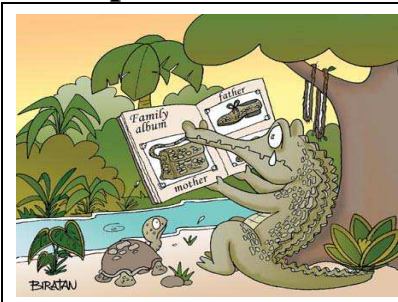
The adjectives express some of the qualities of the noun they refer to. There are some important things you must know about the adjectives in English:

- 1.- They have no plural form (big = grande/grandes)
- 2.- They have no gender , masculine or feminine (old = viejo/vieja)
- 3.- They are placed before the noun (a new car = un coche nuevo)

Los adjetivos expresan algunas de las cualidades del nombre/sustantivo al que acompañan. Estas son algunas de las cosas importantes que debes saber sobre los adjetivos en inglés:

- 1.- No tienen plural (big = grande/grandes)

- 3.- Van delante del nombre (a new car = un coche nuevo)

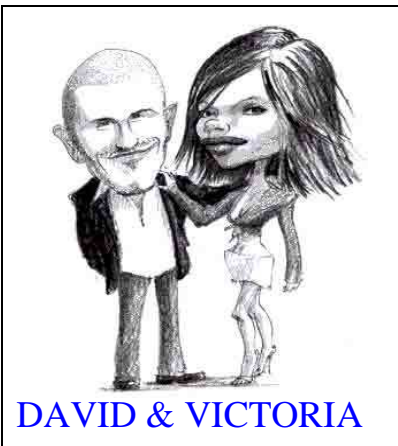
