**WANT TO**.....( will)

Answer the following questions by proving an intention or plan

**Example: A → Why are you saving money?**

**B → I am saving money because I'm going to buy a new house**

**C → Really? I didn't know you wanted to buy a new house.**

B → ( to make a party with my classmates)
