PHIL: Hi, guys, what are you doing?

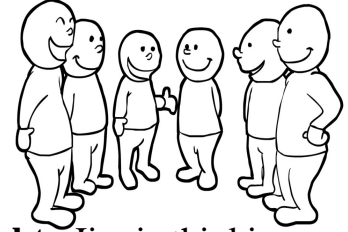
PETER: We're just talking . Do you want to join us?
