

THE EXPRESSION OF THE FUTURE. USES

1.- FUTURE SIMPLE:

- “The weather forecast says **it will rain** tomorrow” (Predicción de futuro)
- “I forgot to call him yesterday. I **will call** him right now” (acción futura no planeada y que decido en el mismo momento de hablar).

2.- TO BE GOING TO:

- “**We are going to** meet at the disco tomorrow”.- (acción futura ya planeada; intención)
- “Those clouds are very dark. I think **it’s going to rain**” (hay evidencias externas que permiten saber casi con toda seguridad que algo va a pasar. Llamado futuro inmediato)

3.- PRESENT CONTINUOUS:

- “**We are meeting** at the disco tomorrow”. Acción futura planeada y ya prácticamente organizada. (muy similar a To be going to)

4.- PRESENT SIMPLE:

- “My train **leaves** at three o’clock tomorrow morning” (horarios y programaciones pre-establecidos)
- “I must get to the bank before it **closes**”. (acciones futuras con oraciones temporales introducidas por conjunciones como after, as, when, as soon as, before, by the time, until.)

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5.- FUTURE CONTINUOUS:

- “Andrew can’t go to the party. **He’ll be working** all day tomorrow” (acción que estará sucediendo en el futuro)

6.- FUTURE PERFECT

- “By this time next year **I will have paid** all the money back to the bank and **We will have found** a new place to live in”.

7.- WAS/ WERE GOING TO:

- “**I was going to** iron the clothes but I didn’t have any time” (expresa una intención en el pasado; a menudo la acción no se llegó a hacer. Es una forma muy habitual para poner excusas)

5.- OTHER STRUCTURES FOR THE FUTURE:

- “In 200 years **there will be** spaceships instead of cars and **there won’t be** any pollution” (futuro del impersonal there is/ there are)
- Sheila will **probably** go to university.
- When you grow up, then you will realise how wrong you are! (Modo subjuntivo)

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6.- USES OF SHALL AND WILL OTHER THAN THE FUTURE

- Shall I..... ?** Shall I help you? (para ofrecerse)
Shall we.....? Shall we go for a walk? (para sugerir)
Will you..... ? Will you do me a favour? (para pedir educadamente)
I will..... Don't worry. I will talk to her (promesa)

7.- WHEN?

Adverbios: TOMORROW, TOMORROW MORNING, THE DAY AFTER TOMORROW, NEXT, IN + time expression. THIS TIME + Adv.

Conjunciones: AFTER, BEFORE, ONCE, AS SOON AS, BY THE TIME, WHEN, UNTIL
